

GLOSSARY OF TERMS:

Bureaucratic:

1a: a body of non-elective government officials

1b: an administrative policy-making group

2: government characterized by specialization of functions, adherence to fixed rules, and a hierarchy of authority

Collaborators:

1: to cooperate with an agency or instrumentality with which one is not immediately connected

Jews:

1: a person belonging to a continuation through descent or conversion of the ancient Jewish people

2: one whose religion is Judaism

Murder:

1: the crime of unlawfully killing a person especially with malice aforethought

Nazi Regime:

1: The German fascist party controlling Germany from 1933 to 1945 under Adolf Hitler

Persecution:

1: the act or practice of persecuting especially those who differ in origin, religion, or social outlook

2: the condition of being persecuted, harassed, or annoyed

A: to harass or punish in a manner designed to injure, grieve, or afflict; *specifically*: to cause to suffer because of belief

State Sponsored:

1: supported by the existing government in power

Systematic:

3a: methodical in procedure or plan <a *systematic* approach><a *systematic* scholar>

3b: marked by thoroughness and regularity <*systematic* efforts>
